Please remember that you do not need a permit to park to attend church services, but only for parking outside of service times. A permit does not give you a guaranteed right to park, but simply the possibility to do so if a space is available. Please avoid parking in the church car park half an hour before or during a service unless you are attending it. Overnight or long stay parking is not permitted, except by special arrangement with the parish office, and these must park in the rear of the hall car park whenever possible. *Thank you*.
