Then parishioners met our local MP Richard Foord and asked about what he was able to do in Parliament to tackle debt in developing countries, enabling them to improve their economies in an environmentally sustainable way. Moving forward the group is working on actions for 2026 including to find a way of replacing the planters around St Teresa's Hall in the spring.
